For many years, the Players' website was hosted without charge by Bryan Griffiths, a service for which the Players have been most thankful. Last fall, however, Bryan notified the Players that he would be unable to continue to offer this service. A committee was formed to find a new host, resulting in the decision to move the website to BlueHost. Thanks to a donation from Lord Xonox, a three-year hosting plan was purchased from BlueHost at no cost to the Players. Nora McBurnett thereafter undertook the technical task of overseeing the actual transfer of our website. Though we were warned that the transfer might create issues with the website for a day or two, Nora accomplished it with only a few hours of interrupted service. Thanks to Nora, the Players' website remains up and running, providing our members and the public the most up-to-date information concerning all of the Players' activities.



The website committee also undertook, at the suggestion of the Players' Historians, the task of scanning the physical show programs from the Players' 98 seasons and posting them on the website. Thus, you can now peruse the programs from nearly all of the Players' past productions by going to our website:
